PREFACE

This Brochure gives brief information about the work done by the Committees of the Haryana Vidhan Sabha during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68. The Brochure has been split up into two parts.

Part I gives the information about the work done by the following Committees of the First Haryana Vidhan Sabha which was constituted on the 1st November, 1966, under the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966 :--

The Committee on Government Assurances, Committee on Subordinate Legislation, Committee of Privileges, Committee on Petitions, Rules Committee, Library Committee and House Committee were also constituted but these Committees did not hold any meeting during the period under review. However, mention of membership of these Committees has been made.
