Constitution of the Committee

1 The Committee on Estimates for the year 2018 2019 consisting of nine members was nominated by the Hon ble Speaker on having been authorized by a motion moved and passed by the Haryana Vidhan Sabha in its sitting held on 6th March 2018 and notified vide Haryana Vidhan Sabha Secretariat Notification No EC 1/2018 19/34 dated 25th April 2018

Appointment of Chairperson

2 Smt Prem Lata M L A was appointed the Chairperson of the Committee

Sittings

3 The Committee held/fixed 64 meetings (at Chandigarh and outside Chandigarh) till the finalization of this Report

Implementations/Recommendations

4 The Committee scrutinized the replies received from the Government in connection with the outstanding recommendations/observations made in their reports for the year 1995 96 1996 97 1998 99 2000 01 2001 02 2003 04 2006 07 2008 09 2010 11 2011 12 2012 13 2013 14 2014 15 and 2016 17 pertaining to Public Health Engineering Health Mines & Geology Tourism Excise & Taxation Environment Development & Panchayats Rural Development Industries & Commerce Welfare of SC s & BC s Tourism Excise & Taxation and Public Health Engineering Irrigation Health Environment Tourism and Health Departments and also orally examined the representatives of the Agriculture and Tourism Department. The Committee dropped the recommendations/observations where it was satisfied with the action taken by the Government. The observations of the Committee of the remaining recommendations/observations in respect of these reports are contained in Appendix II of this Report

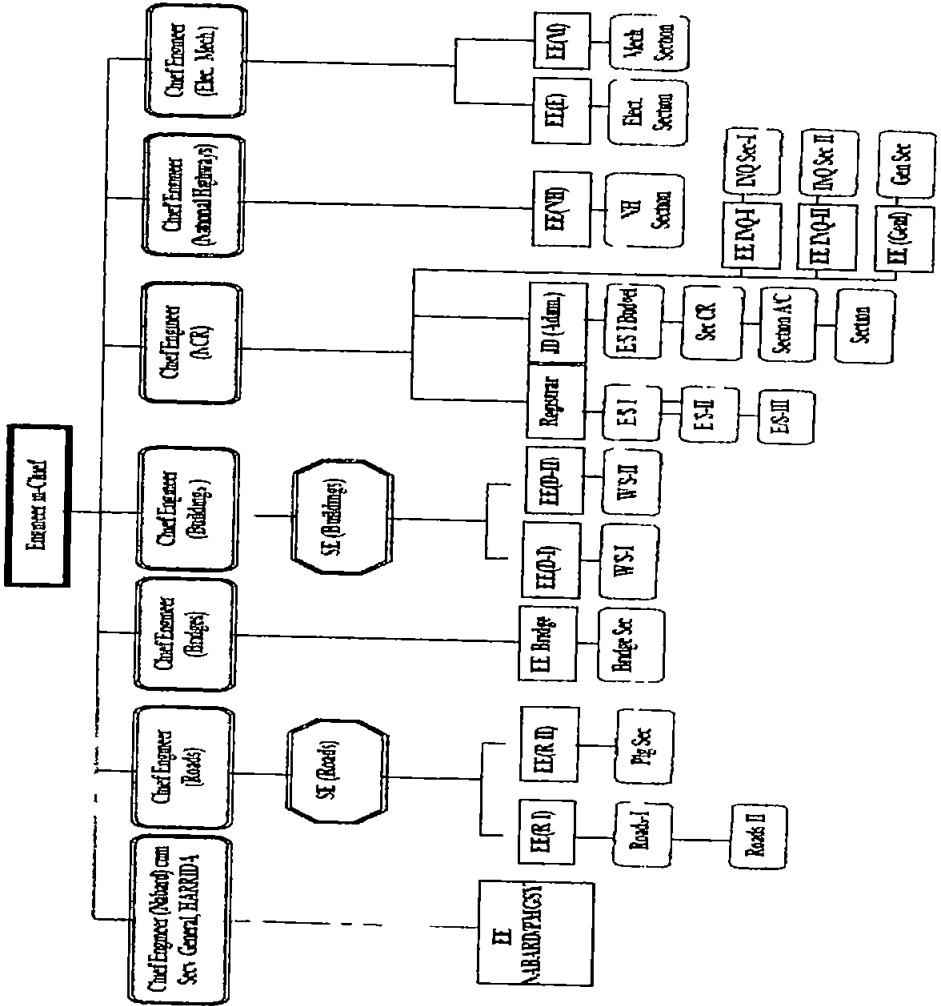
General Observation – Finance Department

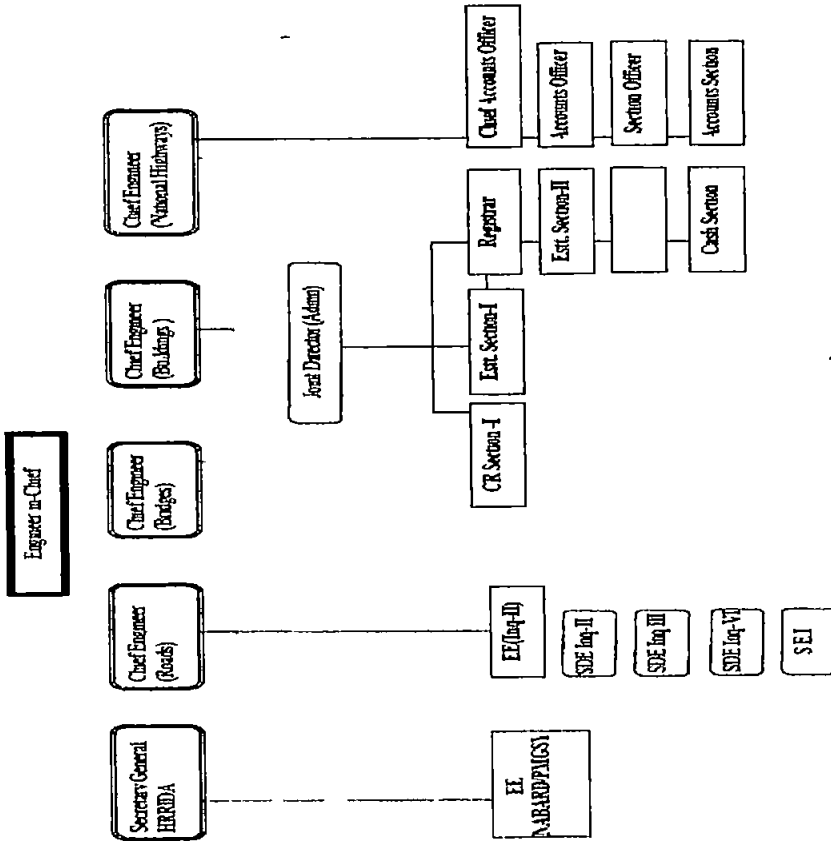

11 Organisational setup and Functions

The Administrative and professional head of the Office is the Registrar. He is responsible for the efficient working of the Office and is also the administrative advisor of Engineer –in Chief in all matters relating to his charges

2 Superintendent / Dy Superintendent

Distribution of work among his staff as evenly as possible checking Training Helping and advising the staff

3 Assistant

Assistants are normally work under the order of superintendent. He notes and drafts on cases relating to these headings and submits the cases through the Head of his Section

4 Clerks

The clerks are entrusted with the work of routine and maintenance of diary file register typing comparing and dispatch

5 Steno/Jr Scale Stenographer

The Stenographers and Steno typists are required to take dictation from the officers with whom they are attached

6 Sr Scale Stenographer

The Stenographers and Steno typists are required to take dictation from the officers with whom they are attached

7 CAO/AO/Section Officer

They are look after/ handle all the financial matter like that pay fixation set up at par annual increment and all type of leaves

8 Personnel Assistant/ Personnel Secretary

The Personnel Assistant and Personnel Secretary are attached with Superintending Engineers/ Chief Engineers/ Executive Engineers

9 Drivers

Drivers are drive the office vehicles for Government Duties

10 Restorers

Restorers are deputed in Branches and maintain the record room

Drawing Cadre

- 1 Circle Head Draftsman** Record of Plans and drawing and maintenance of register of buildings roads and Bridges Check Rough Cost Estimate Tender DNIT etc

- 2 **Head Draftsman** Preparation and Scrutiny of Estimates contractors and documents etc
- 3 **Assistant Draftsman** Maintenance of accounts of survey and Drawing instruments in the Division
- 4 **Tracer** Making Drawings and records of estimate DNIT Tenders Rough Cost Estimate and under line Head point with green marker in Estimates

- 11 **Junior Engineer / Section Officer 56** The smallest working unit in the B&R Branch is known as Section in the charge of a Sectional Officer whose principal functions are as under
- (i) To prepare petty requisitions and plans and estimates for special repairs and additions and alterations
 - (ii) To give Nishans for works to be done in his section
 - (iii) To carry out survey and leveling work when required to do so
 - (iv) To supervise the actual execution of building and roads works and repair in his section done through the contractors or by daily labour and to see that they are executed in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by the competent authority for the said work with sound materials He shall also maintain the Register of progress and instructions on all major works and present them to all inspecting officers on their visits for recording their orders If any
 - (v) To make arrangements for adequate strength of labour at economical rates within the sanctioned rates when a work is required to be done departmentally
 - (vi) To maintain accounts of all the stock and T & P in his charge their receipts and issues and to maintain register of materials at side
 - (vii) To take measurements of work and to assist the Sub Divisional Officer or Executive Engineer in measurements or check measurement of work
 - (viii) To record, in time the measurement of small works below foundations In case of large works to get the work measured up in time from the Sub Divisional office before such works get covered over To prepare running bills of all works and final bills of such works as cost less than one lakh of rupees and to submit them to the S D O
 - (ix) To put up measurement books regularly to his Sub Divisional Officer for order of payment at least twice a month
 - (x) To supervise labour employed on daily wages and to submit labour reports daily to the SDO and to supervise the regular gangs and to check their attendance on his visit to roads under his charge

- (xi) To prepare maintain and submit in time all rolls of work charged establishment and to make payments to work charged establishment and to permanent gangs on behalf of and under the instructions of the Sub Divisional Officer when required to do so
- (xii) To keep a vigilant control over expenditure and report progress of work to his SDO either daily or periodically as may be ordered
- (xiii) To report to the S D O immediately occurrence of any serious accidents etc in his section and to ensure that no damage take place to the Government property in his charge
- (xiv) To check the Visitors register of all rest houses in his charge at least once a month and to receive collections of rents etc from Chowkidars of rest houses for depositing them in the Sub Divisional Office
- (xv) To keep Government land property free from encroachments and to promptly bring to the notice of his Sub Divisional Officer in writing when any encroachment temporary or permanent is threatened or actually takes place

In the reply to the questionnaire of the Committee regarding complaints received and enquiry conducted regarding irregularities/ embezzlements/ misappropriation of funds against the officers/ officials of the department The department replied that no such complaint has been received during the last three years but during oral examination department representatives informed to the Committee that in another cases departmental Officers/Officials have been charge sheated **Thus the Committee recommends that the detailed report be submitted to the Committee in which cases Officer/Officials were charge sheated/inquiry conducted**
