INTRODUCTION

1. I, the Chairman of the Committee on Government Assurances, having been authorised by the Committee to submit the report on their behalf, present their Fifth Report.
2. The Committee were nominated by the Speaker, Haryana Vidhan Sabha under Rule 237 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Haryana Legislative Assembly on the 3rd July, 1973. —*vide* Gazette notification No. CB/A-2/73-54/56, dated the 4th July, 1973.
3. The work done by the Committee after the presentation of the Fourth Report on the 30th March, 1973 is set forth in this Report.
4. The Committee are thankful to the Administrative Secretaries/Heads of Departments and other officers who appeared before them from time to time in connection with the implementation of Assurances.
5. The Committee also place on record their high appreciation of the whole-hearted co-operation and assistance given to them by the Secretary, Haryana Vidhan Sabha, and his staff.

REPORT

1. The Committee on Government Assurances for the year 1973-74 consisting of nine members was nominated by the Speaker, Haryana Vidhan Sabha and notified in the Gazette,—*vide* Haryana Vidhan Sabha notification No. CB/A-2/73-74/56, dated the 4th July, 1973. Chaudhri Chand Ram was appointed as Chairman of the Committee by the Speaker. The Committee held 30 sittings since its constitution.

SCRUTINY OF ASSURANCES

2. The Committee scrutinised the statements made by Ministers on the floor of the House during the Sessions held in August—October, 1972 and March—June, 1973. The statements, which in the opinion of the Committee constituted assurances were sent to the Administrative Secretaries concerned for intimating the manner in which and the extent to which the Government had implemented them. The Committee could not scrutinise the statement of assurances given on the floor of the House during the Session held in November, 1973 because of the non-receipt of the comments thereon from the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana up to the 27th March, 1974 the date when the Committee finalised its Report. The successor Committee may, therefore, take up this work.

3. The Committee scrutinised the replies received from the Government from time to time in regard to the implementation of the assurances shown as outstanding in Appendix II of the Fourth Report as also the replies containing the action taken by Government to implement the assurances given on the floor of the House during the Sessions held up to June, 1973. The Committee made certain observations in respect of some of the replies scrutinised by them in order to elicit further information from the Government and dropped the rest.

4. The Committee orally examined the representatives of the following departments in respect of the implementation of the outstanding assurances concerning them and in view of the position explained by them the Committee decided to keep certain assurances pending and dropped the rest :—

- (1) Revenue. (2) Development. (3) Panchayat. (4) Animal Husbandry. (5) Irrigation. (6) Electricity. (7) Public Works (B.&R.). (8) Education. (9) Transport. (10) Public Works (Public Health). (11) Industries.

5. The Committee also had the opportunity of meeting the members of the Committee on Government Assurances of Kerala Legislature during its visit to Chandigarh on 22nd November, 1973 and discussed with them various procedural matters relating to the working of the Committee on Government Assurances in their respective Legislatures.

6. The Committee reviewed the assurances appearing in Appendix II of the Fourth Report. The Committee dropped some of the assurances which lost their utility due to lapse of time.

7. The position in regard to the assurances given on the floor of the House up to the Sessions held in January, 1972 of the Haryana Vidhan Sabha was shown in the Fourth Report of the Committee which was presented to the House on the 30th March, 1973. A statement showing the number of assurances given on the floor of the House during the Sessions held in August, October, 1972, March, April and June, 1973 is given in Appendix I.

**Consideration of replies received from Government in regard to the implementation
of Assurances**

8. The Committee scrutinised the replies received from the Government from time to time up to the 25th March, 1974 in regard to the implementation of the outstanding assurances. The Committee made certain observations in respect of some of replies scrutinised by them in order to elicit further information from the Government (Appendix II) and dropped the rest. The replies received from the Government after the 25th March, 1974 may be taken up by the successor Committee.

9. The assurances which have either been dropped because they had outlived their utility due to lapse of time or in respect of which the Committee were satisfied with the action taken by the Government to implement them have not been printed in this Report.

10. The Committee reviewed the outstanding assurances appearing in Appendix II of the Fourth Report. The Committee after further reviewing the assurances dropped some of them. The assurances which have been dropped in this process have not been reprinted in this Report. The Government Departments may, therefore, not send replies to those assurances which do not find place in this Report.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS IN REGARD TO IMPLEMENTATION OF ASSURANCES

11. The Committee in their First Report recommended that—

"Normally the assurances should be implemented by the Government within three months from the date on which those assurances are given. In case it is not possible to implement an assurance within this period the cause of delay should be communicated to the Committee so that it may judge whether the reasons given for the delay are adequate or otherwise."

The above recommendation was reiterated by the Committee in their Second, Third and Fourth Reports. The Committee are pained to point out that their above recommendation is still not being followed in letter and spirit. The Committee have thus come to an irresistible conclusion that the importance is not being paid to the Committee's work. The Committee, therefore, recommended that the Administrative Secretaries should pay personal attention in the matter to see that no delay occurs anywhere in implementing assurances.

12. In order to avoid delay in the implementation of assurances the Committee recommend that the Government should issue instructions to all Administrative Secretaries and Heads of Departments/their representatives to note the Assurances concerning them at the time when these are given by the Ministers on the floor of the Vidhan Sabha and initiate action rather than waiting for formal communication to this effect from the Vidhan Sabha Secretariat.

TYPICAL CASES OF INORDINATE DELAY

The Committee have come across cases where inordinate delay has occurred

in taking action to implement the outstanding assurances. Some of the cases are cited below:—

(i) Medical and Health

The following assurance, (Assurance No. 392 of the Fourth Report) arising out of the S. Q. No. 1245 by Shri Mangal Sein regarding complaint against the Doctor of Primary Health Centre, Kalanaur (Rohtak), given by the Minister on the floor of the House on the 4th August, 1971.

"Parts (c) and (d). Chief Medical Officer, Rohtak was entrusted with these complaints....."

The said assurance was forwarded to the Administrative Secretary to Government, Haryana, Medical and Health Department,—*vide* this Secretariat D.O. letter No. CB/A-28/72-73/23069, dated 27th November, 1972. The Committee are pained to note that no reply to the assurance under reference has been received even up till now.

(ii) Agriculture

The following assurance (Assurance No. 40 of the Fourth Report) arising out of the Budget Speech of Finance Minister, dated 12th January, 1972 ; (Assurances No. 41 and 42 of the Fourth Report) arising out of in reply to the debate on the Budget for 1972-73 on 13th January, 1972 ; and (assurance No. 44 of the Fourth Report) arising out of Supplementary asked by Shri Daya Krishan on S.Q. No. 1363 "How many tube wells can be installed in all under the augmentation scheme ?"

The said Assurances were forwarded to the Administrative Secretary to Government, Haryana, Agriculture Department,—*vide* this Secretariat D.O. letter No. CB/A-3/72-73/23104, dated 27th November, 1972. Since then no reply has been received in respect of assurances under reference. The Committee take a serious view of the inordinate delay involved in this case.

(iii) Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes

The following assurance (Assurance No. 139 of the Fourth Report) arising out of Reply to debate on Governor's Address given by the Minister on the floor of the House on 23rd February, 1966 :—

"We have decided to advance loans to Harijans up to Rs 2,000 without any condition."

The said assurance was forwarded to the Department by the Punjab Vidhan Sabha. The Committee on Government Assurances of the Haryana Vidhan Sabha decided to pursue the Assurance under reference and the Secretary to Government, Haryana, was informed accordingly. The assurance under reference has been shown as outstanding in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Reports of the Committee. The Committee regret to note that the Department has not moved at all into the matter even after a period of about 7 years and the assurance which was given 8 years back still remains unimplemented.

The assurance No. 145 and No. 147 of the Fourth Report were given by the Ministers on the floor of the House on 16th February, 1971 and were forwarded to the Department,—*vide* this Secretariat D.O. letter No. CB/A-79/71-72/19948, dated 9th August, 1971. What to speak of sending final reply intimating the Committee about the action taken by the Department for the implementation of the assurance under question the Department has not shown the courtesy expected

of it to send an interim reply. The Committee are constrained to draw an irresistible conclusion that the Department has not attached due importance to the Committees' Work. Such types of gross negligence on the part of Government Departments should be avoided in the case of the implementation of the assurances given by the Ministers on the floor of the House, in order to check the rising of the same matter perpetually in session after session of the Vidhan Sabha.

The matter was discussed with the representatives of the Punjab State and the Union Territory of Chandigarh, on 30th January, 1970. The Punjab Government agreed to supply the requisite <i>pro forma</i> in which the statement of assets and liabilities are to be prepared in respect of each inter-State Corporate body. This was done for the sake of uniformity. The <i>pro forma</i> have not so far been received from the Punjab Government, in spite of repeated reminders, the last reminder having been issued on 24th July, 1970. There is no doubt that the Farmers Service Centres at Ambala and Jind started functioning before 30th June, 1971. The Centres at Rohtak and Gurgaon

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could not be set up before 30th June, 1971, on account of non-availability of suitable lands for this purpose. At Rohtak we decided to purchase evacuee land bearing Khasra No. 8091 measuring 2,100 yards situated at Gohana Chowk, Rohtak but when we went to take possession of this land, Municipal Committee filed a civil suit in the Court of Sub-Judge the matter regarding purchase of this land is now sub-judice. For the time being we have hired some premises on Hissar-Rohtak Road on rent and the centre has started functioning there. At Gurgaon, we have selected and the land is being acquired through Land Acquisition Proceedings. The steps for setting up a Farmers Service Centre at Dadri will be taken as soon as our above four centres start functioning properly.

Besides these Farmers Service Centres, the Corporation has set up two sub-Centres, one each at Mandi Adampur and Sirsa and two Sale-cum-Service Centres one each at Karnal and Ladwa for providing custom hiring facilities to the farmers of these areas.
